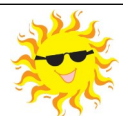
Having Fun in the Sun!

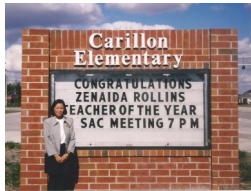

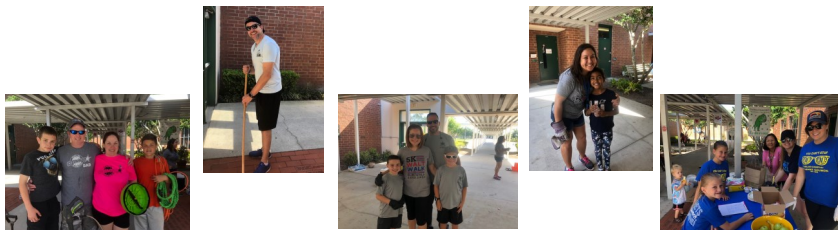
Oviedo History
